The SA Unionists T-Shirt Design Competition

The Competition is open from August 13th 2021 and entries must be received no later than 11:59pm ACDT on Labour Day, October 4th 2021. Entries will be considered by SA Unions office bearers following closure of the Competition. The winner will be notified via email. SA Unions ABN: 49 207 741 085 of 170 Greenhill Road Parkside (Promoter) is conducting the Competition.

ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

- 1.Competition entry is free.
- 2.Entry into the Competition is deemed acceptance of these Competition Terms and Conditions.
- 3.Competition entry is only open to financial members of trade unions who reside in South Australia.
- 4.The Promoter will accept only one entry per entrant per category. The entry categories are General, Youth and Women.
- 5.Entry into the Competition is by email to saunions@saunions.org . Entries must contain:
(a)the contact details (address, telephone number and preferred email address) of the entrant; and
(b)a high resolution image which is inspired by the culture, values and vision of the South Australian Union Movement and suitable for appearing on apparel including t-shirts (Design).
- 6.Once an entry is submitted, no changes to that entry will be permitted.

DESIGN SUBMISSIONS

- 7.Each Design must be in digital format and will not be returned by the Promoter.
- 8.Designs must be wholly original. Entrants warrant that their Design does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party.
- 9.Each entrant grants to the Promoter an exclusive, royalty free, worldwide, unrestricted and perpetual license to adapt, modify and use the Design in and on promotional, communications and marketing material, including on apparel which will be sold by the Promoter to the public.

PRIZE

- 10.The prize available to be won will be an equal share per category of the prize pool, which is \$1000 as at 24/08/21 (Prize).
- 11.The winner of the Prize will be determined by decision of SA Unions office bearers.
- 12.The selection of the winning entry is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 13.The Promoter reserves the right to request the winner to provide identity and/or proof of entry eligibility prior to the transfer of the Prize and announcement of the winner.
- 14.The Prize must be accepted by the winner subject to any applicable conditions. The winner of the Prize is solely responsible for complying with any Prize conditions and expiry.

CONDUCT OF THE COMPETITION

- 15.To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not responsible or liable for:
 - a)inaccurate/incorrect transcription of entry information;
 - b)unauthorised human intervention in any part of the Competition; or
 - c)electronic or human error which may occur in the administration of the Competition.
- 16.The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify from the Competition any entrant who the Promoter has reason to believe has breached any of these terms and conditions or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the Competition.
- 17.In the event of being announced the winner of the Competition, each entrant consents to the Promoter announcing their full name and union affiliation in the Promoter's communications with members and the public, including on the Promoter's social media pages.
