

# Australia Post Delivery uniform update: online ordering process now open

Dear members,

Due to COVID-19, the ordinary uniform bulk drop for delivery operational areas has been interrupted.

A new process has been implemented for this year's uniform order to facilitate the ordering of new lower garments.

The ordering process has gone online – at the website <http://uniforms.auspost> – designed to minimise touching of surfaces involved in the ordinary ordering process.

If you have an android device, you can also access the ordering process by search for and downloading the mobile app “Australia Post Uniform”.

To place your order, you'll need to login to the system using:

**Username:** [yourAPSnumber@auspost.com.au](mailto:yourAPSnumber@auspost.com.au)

**Password:** the first three characters of your first name and APS. The first letter must be a CAPITAL.

**For members who do not have access to a smart device, or the internet at home, paper based forms will be made available on request. Some larger facilities have implemented their own local processes for managing this process.**

Orders open today and will close on Thursday, 17 September.
